ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 17-1

Ordinance No. 17-1A

At a meeting of the Township Board of Coldwater, Branch County, Michigan, held at the Coldwater Township Hall on March 5, 2018, at 5:30 p.m., Township Board Member Clerk Morrison moved to adopt the following Ordinance, which motion was supported by Township Board Member Trustee Daniels:

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 17-1 to modify a property owner's duty to destroy weeds within 10 days of receiving notice of noxious weeds on the property owner's property.

THE TOWNSHIP OF COLDWATER ORDAINS:

Section 2. Amendment to Ordinance Section 2.A. 1 of Ordinance 17-1 shall be amended to read as follows:

1. On which noxious weeds are found to destroy such weeds within 10 days of receiving notice that such weeds are a detriment to the public health and prevent their regrowth; and

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance Amendment shall take effect 7 days following the publication or posting after final adoption by the Township Board.

The Ordinance was declared ADOPTED.




